

SUGARLAND RUN HOA - TENNIS COURT RULES

Section 1

<u>Membership</u>: Membership to the Sugarland Run tennis courts is limited to residents, who are, in accordance with the ByLaws of the association, current in the assessments.

Each member MUST provide the association with one of the following forms of identification when applying for a tennis court key.

- A. Valid driver's license.
- B. Tenants must provide a copy of their CURRENT lease and their valid driver's license.

Section 2 <u>Tennis Court Use</u>:

- A. Smooth soled shoes only permitted on courts.
- B. First come first serve basis only.
- C. Order of use determined by placing rackets in the racket hang located on west end of courts.
- D. Length of play is one hour or completion of 2 sets, whichever occurs first.
- E. Players have priority over individuals practicing.
- F. No food, pets, equipment, wheeled vehicles or other objects permitted on courts.
- G. Junior players must yield their court to senior players at the end of the current set after 5 P.M.
- H. Family usage is restricted to one court at a time unless no one is waiting.
- I. Lock the tennis court gate after each use.
- J. Courts restricted to tennis ONLY.

Section 3

<u>Payment</u>: There is a \$10 deposit required to obtain a tennis court key. Upon the return of the key to the Sugarland Run HOA, the deposit will be returned to the resident.

Payment must be in the form of cash, check or money order.

Your cooperation in observing these rules is necessary to insure fair use of the tennis courts.
