COMMUNITY CORNER

Residents of Sugarland Run,

Reduce, Reuse, Recycle!

I learned this past month that glass bottles and containers are no longer being collected by our respective trash companies. The companies are not the ones who decide what is to be collected for recycling, though. Loudoun County Government decides what will be recycled.

I wondered how glass, paper, cardboard, and plastic could be feasibly collected in one bin, one collection truck where it is crushed, and then be sorted out at the trash company or a county waste transfer station. We are instructed to rinse recyclables before putting them in the bin. Then I heard that wet paper/cardboard was not acceptable. I also heard that plastic bagged recyclables were not acceptable. With such rules in place, a single-stream recycling program is destined to fail.

I started thinking about the milk delivery that used to occur door-to-door (before this neighborhood existed) where the glass bottles were collected to be reused. My grandparents had a couple of those glass bottles in their basement. And then some pocket change could be recovered for taking glass soda bottles to be recycled. There are 10 states and Guam that have "Bottle Bills" and you can find more information about them at www.ncsl.org (https://www.ncsl.org/research/environment-and-natural-resources/state-beverage-container-laws.aspx)

Nearby, Sterling Park does have a Community Recycling Center located at Park View Highschool, 400 West Laurel Avenue, Sterling, VA 20164. It is next to the football stadium and is open 7 days per week during daylight hours. The recycling is collected from the site on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. For more information about what is acceptable for collection at this facility, please visit www.loudoun.gov.

Looks like I'll be driving over to the Recycling Center periodically now.

TO SCHEDULE AN APPOINTMENT PLEASE CALL THE OFFICE AT (703) 430 – 4500. OR YOU CAN EMAIL ADMINISTRATIVE@SRHOA.COM OR ADMIN.ASSISTANT@SRHOA.COM

If you have not received a pool pass yet, each member of your household six (6) years and older will need to come to the SRHOA office and have their picture taken.

Each member MUST provide the association with one of the following forms of identification:

- A. Driver's license with the current SRHOA property address
- B. Walker's permit (non-driver picture ID issued by DMV) with the current SRHOA property address
- C. Recent (within three months) Utility Bill with resident's name listed
- D. VA voter registration with the property address
- E. Recent (within three months) Bank Statement with the SRHOA property address
- F. Children between the ages of 6 and 18 must provide a current report card of the schools in the community (unless providing a driver's license) and must be accompanied by a parent with either A, B, C, D, or E (above).
- G. Tenants must provide a copy of their CURRENT lease and the owner MUST sign the pool application granting authorization for their tenants to use the pool. Tenants are also required to provide proof of residency with either A, B, C, D, or E (above).. (Landlords must release their rights to use the pool annually to their tenants.)

HOMEOWNER'S ACCOUNT(S) MUST BE PAID UP TO DATE IN ORDER TO USE THE POOL.

TENANTS MUST CONTACT THEIR LANDLORDS REGARDING POOL PASS ACTIVATION.

All tenants, regardless of if 2021 pool passes were received, must contact their landlords regarding the activation of 2022 pool passes.
