PROCEDURES FOR 2022 HHW EVENTS

- The event is a drive-thru, in which residents are instructed to remain in their vehicles and allow event staff to unload any items accepted for disposal.
- Gasoline will be emptied from personal gas cans and the cans will be returned upon request.

<u>Limit per Household</u>: Up to 15 gallons of liquid household waste / 40 pounds of solid household waste (Container size no larger than five gallons)

**Please note that participants must be able to provide proof of Loudoun County residencies such as a driver's license or utility bill if requested.

The county also conducts two hazardous waste disposal collection events each year <u>for local businesses</u> under the Business Hazardous Waste Program.
