WHAT'S HAPPENING

Concerns With Loitering, Littering, etc. – If you have concerns about loitering, littering, or other undesirable activities, please report those to the Sheriff's Office. There are several online forms, depending on the nature of the concern, at www.loudoun.gov/4700/Citizen-Feedback. Submitting your concern using the online form helps document the issue. If you believe the area might be HOA property, please also notify the HOA office. A special community meeting addressing the Sugarland Square Shopping Center (i.e., the 7-11 area) will be held for residents to share concerns directly with the Sheriff's Office and community leaders. This meeting has not yet been scheduled – notices will be posted in the future newsletter(s) and online.

Biking in Sugarland Run – Reminder that on Saturday, March 18, there will be a free bicycle safety and maintenance workshop at the HOA Community Center. Beginning at 8:00 a.m. free bicycle repairs will be offered to anyone bringing in their bike. At 10:00 the bicycle safety and maintenance workshop will begin. 

Fun for the community by community volunteers.



SMOKE ALARM SAFETY

Following the recent tragic fire and loss of life in our neighborhood, stemming from a malfunctioning e-bike battery/charger and lack of working smoke detectors, please take notice of the following suggestions from the Loudoun County Fire Marshall's Office:

Smoke alarms that are properly installed and maintained play a vital role in reducing fire deaths and injuries. If there is a fire in your home, smoke alarms provide the critical first warning and give you time to get out. Remember these tips:

- Test your alarms monthly by pushing the test button.
- Replace batteries in all smoke alarms at least once a year. If an alarm "chirps", warning the battery is low, replace the battery right away.
- Replace all smoke alarms when they are 10 years old or sooner if they do not respond properly.
- Smoke alarms should be located inside every bedroom, outside each sleeping area and on every level of the home, including the basement.
- To get more information on smoke alarms or to request a free smoke alarm assessment visit www.loudoun.gov/smokealarms or call 703-737-8093.
- Have a home escape plan so everyone knows what to do if the smoke alarm sounds. Practice your plan!

As more and more products are using lithium ion and lithium polymer batteries, fire departments across the country are seeing an increase in fires caused when these batteries malfunction. When lithium batteries are damaged or fail, they can overheat, catch on fire, and even lead to explosions. Following these easy tips can keep you safe:

- ALWAYS follow the manufacturer's instructions for charging and storage.
- Use the correct battery, cord, and power adapter, and ensure cords and wires are not damaged or worn.
- Monitor batteries while charging and do not overcharge the device or device battery.
- Keep batteries and devices at room temperature.
- Charge and store batteries away from anything flammable. Never charge a battery or device under your pillow, on your bed, or near a couch.
- Ensure you properly dispose of used batteries. Instructions for the proper disposal of lithium batteries are at www.loudoun.gov/342/Household-Hazardous-Waste.
