
WHAT'S HAPPENING

Community Survey: Thank you to the 294 residents who provided feedback through the Sugarland Run Community Survey. The HOA board and staff are reviewing your input and will be discussing the results over the next few months.

HOA Facebook Group: The Sugarland Run HOA has created an online forum to allow residents and/or members to discuss community issues. While there has been an active resident-run Facebook Group in operation for many years, the Virginia judicial system ruled that such groups do not meet the requirements of the law governing HOAs. Therefore, the SRHOA has created a Facebook Group administered by the HOA board and staff that encourages residents/members to communicate with each other and with the board. All residents/members of the SRHOA, Sugarland Run Townhome HOA, Sugarland Square HOA, and Hunington Ridge 1, 2, and 3 HOAs are invited to join this new group. You can find the group by searching on Facebook for the group named "Sugarland Run HOA Community." You can also locate the group by going to the Sugarland Run Homeowners Association Facebook page and finding the group associated with it. The group is a private group. Membership in the group is restricted to residents and/or owners. In requesting to join the group, you will be asked to answer several questions, which will be verified by HOA staff. Once verified, your request to join the group will be approved. Please note the process of approval may take several days. Thank you in advance for your support as we get this new community communication tool up and running.


