#### WHAT'S HAPPENING

**2024 Association Dues & Budget**: The Sugarland Run HOA and Townhome HOA have approved the 2024 Budgets and Monthly Assessments. The 2024 monthly assessments for Sugarland Run HOA & Sugarland Square Townhomes members will remain the same at \$78.45 and \$39.20 for Hunington Ridge members. The monthly assessments for the Sugarland Run Townhome HOA will be \$80.42 beginning January 1, 2024. Coupons will arrive in December for all homeowners. If you do not receive them by mid-January, please contact the office at 703-430-4500.

Yard Waste and Christmas Tree Disposal: Yard waste should either be retained on your property or properly transported to the county landfill. Christmas trees can be dropped off for recycling at several nearby sites, including Claude Moore Park. Waste hauling companies often offer yard waste and Christmas tree services – if you have private trash service, please contact your waste hauler for more information. Do not use HOA commons areas to dispose of your yard waste or Christmas trees.

**On-Street Parking:** When parking on streets, do not block access points for adjacent sidewalks or crosswalks. Do not park vehicles in a way that blocks visibility at street corners. Unless marked otherwise, parked vehicles should be no closer than 30 feet to street corners. Ticketing and/or towing of violators is possible. Residents are asked to call Loudoun County Sheriff's Office at 703.777.1021 to report possible violations. LCSO will respond to parking complaints when notified.

#### **Snow Removal:**

The main streets throughout Sugarland Run are maintained, including snow removal and ice treatment, by VDOT. The parking areas within the Townhome HOA are maintained, including snow removal and ice treatment, by the THOA. The Community Center parking lot is maintained, including snow removal and ice treatment, by the SRHOA. Usually, several inches must accumulate before plows will be deployed. The HOA contractor is scheduled to service Sugarland Run after VDOT has plowed the main streets. Snow removal from sidewalks is the responsibility of residents – the sidewalk fronting the home is to be kept clear of snow by that homeowner. The majority of the asphalt paths throughout Sugarland Run are maintained by the HOAs as recreational amenities and therefore snow removal is not performed.

Job Posting – Sugarland Run HOA Rental Facilitator

#### **Description**

Sugarland Run Homeowners Association is seeking an individual to perform the opening and closing responsibilities for after-hours private rental events at the Sugarland Run HOA Community Center and Office Building (located at 200 Greenfield Court, Sterling, VA).

After-hours periods during which rentals may be scheduled are:

- 5:00 p.m. to Midnight on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday
- 8:00 a.m. to Midnight on Saturday and Sunday

This position is an on-call position. The HOA Rental Facilitator will usually be provided at least two weeks advance notice of scheduled rentals. Hours will vary and will often include several Saturday rentals per month requiring midnight closings. Most rentals are scheduled on weekends.

Pay is \$50.00 per event.

#### Requirements

Opening and Closing Process:

- Arrive at the facility 15 minutes before the start of the rental to verify the space is ready for the Renter.
- Greet the Renter and confirm they are the Renter according to the Contract.
- Inspect the facility with the Renter, completing the "Before Rental" checklist.
- Instruct the Renter as to the operations of the facility.
- · Provide the Renter with keys to the rented space.
- Remind the Renter you will return at the end time indicated on the contract to close the rental.
- Provide the Renter with your phone number to call with questions or concerns during the rental.
- Return to the facility at the end time indicated on the Contract.
- Inspect the facility with the Renter, completing the "After Rental" checklist.
- Collect the keys from the Renter.
- Turn off lights and lock doors upon exiting.
- Deposit the completed checklist in the HOA drop box.

The HOA Rental Facilitator is also required to:

- Ensure the Renter vacates the facility at the time specified in the contract.
- Respond in person as necessary to building alarms and Renter issues during the rental period.
- Report incidents and suspicious activity to HOA management (and if necessary, 911)
- Perform this duty professionally and lawfully.
- Be reliable and punctual for openings and closings.

This is part-time employment and hours will vary based on scheduled events.
