- Management has contacted the account representative at Wells Fargo to discuss the various certificates of deposit (CD) options available. Management also recommended a financial analysis to the board of directors to help determine the course of action the board can take on this matter

## **DECISION ITEMS**

Ratification of Vote for Drainage Repairs Simeon Lane and Drury Circle: Kevin Leet MOTIONED to ratify and approve the electronic vote of the drain cleaning on Simeon Lane and Drury Circle for a total of up to \$3,545.00. David Meier SECONDED the motion, and it <u>PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.</u>

CD Investment of Money Market Funds: Kevin Leet MOTIONED to approve the money market funds of 50,000 on a CD for January 2026, at 4.25%, 50,000 on July 29, 2026, at 4.25%, 50,000 on January 28, 2027, at 4.25%, 50,000 on January 31, 2028, at 4.2%, 50,000 at February 1, 2029, at 4.2% and a 50,000 CD for 5 years January 30, 2030, at 7%. David Meier SECONDED the motion, and it <u>PASSED UNANIMOUSLY.</u>

  - A. The board discussed the 2025 Elections. There is one open seat for election.   - A. The board would like to initiate the breakdown cost of the contract's yearly fees.
